To enable the overall development of our students, the Career Development Center at GMRIT regularly conducts Training Programs. These training programs are meant for improving proficiency in English Language, Personality Development, Aptitude Tests, Group Discussions and Interview Skills, which help the student in the Placement process. The college expects 100% attendance from the students for the training programs.

To strengthen our placements, we have a placement policy according to which a student is eligible for placements, if he / she has:

- ❖ A minimum aggregate of 60% marks at the end of the third year - second semester without any backlogs.
- ❖ A Minimum of 80% attendance in the training Programs organized by the college.

Any student with a track record of indiscipline shall not be considered for campus placements.

We earnestly solicit your co-operation in encouraging your ward to attend all the training programs organized by the college and ensure a good academic performance, so that he / she would be eligible for the campus placements.

Further, we would like to take this opportunity to bring to your notice some of our campus regulations:

- **Ragging is strictly prohibited. If any student indulges in Ragging he / she is liable to be dismissed from the college.**
